Our Henley office helps just over 3,000 clients per year by phone, email and face to face. We have about 45 volunteers, supported by just over 1 FTE members of staff.

All our funding is raised locally and we are very grateful to SODC, Henley Town Council and the many local businesses and charities who enable us to exist in order to support the local community.

We are part of Oxfordshire South and Vale Citizens Advice, which provides us with back office support and enables us to share and learn from our sister advice centres in Thame, Didcot and Abingdon.
