Fully-accessible throughout, its facilities include a multi-sensory room, comfortable lounge and spacious dining area equipped with TV and computers. One of Chiltern Centre's aims is to help families with disabled children enjoy every day experiences most of us take for granted.

Today, the Centre is not only highly regarded by professionals, families, and the local community, but continues to grow its portfolio of services.
