Again it has been another very busy year at the 60+ Club. With over 100 members, we provide a friendly and relaxing venue for the senior citizens of the town. Our chef Marek provides healthy meals Monday, Wednesday and Friday. At £6 for a main course with pudding, members think this very good value. We average between 20-30 members at each sitting. We also have the services of a chiropodist on Mondays at a very reasonable rate of £20. Bianca, our hairdresser again offers excellent value and is at the Club Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

We welcome our new Manager Carolynne, who takes over from Paula, and Carolynne shares the position with Sharon. The Club is run by the Management Committee, made up of the Mayor of Henley, Town Councillors and volunteers, who meet quarterly.

This year the Club has been the grateful beneficiary of the generosity of many of the organisations in the town. When our commercial oven died just before Christmas, the Tony Lane Foundation funded a replacement and they are helping us with a re-furbishment of the entire kitchen area. They are also funding our annual Tony Lane Party. The Henley Festival is treating us to a performance and free lunch for our members once again. Murphys, the building contractor, painted the inside of our building and gave very generous presents to us for our Christmas raffle. Tomalins paid for our Christmas Lunch. Copas gave us turkeys. Invesco Perpetual have paid to recover our chairs and for a new computer. We took part in the Living Advent Calendar with Manor Care Homes providing the hospitality and we will be hosting the Repair Café when it commences in the Spring. Finally we would like to thank Henley Town Council who own our building and allow us to use it free of charge, and for their generous yearly grant.

Membership costs just £20 a year and brings with it so many benefits. All are welcome to visit any time and pick up one of our new leaflets. We are open 10am to 4pm Monday to Friday.
