

This is the report for The Lions Club of Henley on Thames.

Henley Lions is made up of 19 local volunteers, who all bring a range of different skills and knowledge to our community.

With the pandemic, our fund raising activities have been sadly curtailed but we have still managed to make donations to many local good causes.

This included Bishopwood School, Henley Music School, Dingley's Promise, First Day's, Henley Sea Cadets, Sue Ryder Hospice, Nomad Food Bank, Rivertime Boat Trips, and Charlie Ilsley.

We also helped towards the funding of a new wheelchair for a local youngster with Spina Bifida.

Over Christmas we delivered 85 Christmas parcels, and Santa's Sleigh visited Henley and Shiplake adhering to all Covid 19 restrictions.

Our Winter Fuel Project has helped 39 individuals including 15 children.

Besides helping our local community we also sent a donation in aid of the Beirut Lebanon bomb.

We also collected 667 pairs of spectacles , which will be sent to help others.

This Easter we are organizing a painting competition for our local Under 10 year olds.

Several Henley Lions have also been helping to co-ordinate parking at our local surgeries during Covid 19 vaccination sessions.
